REQUIRED/RECOMMENDED TOOLS AND SUPPLIES 2019-2020 School Year

AUTOMOTIVE TECHNOLOGY

Appropriate shoes/boots, Appropriate clothing; i.e., work pants or blue jeans (NO SHORTS or Nylon Pajama Pants). Safety glasses (first pair provided by KACC), Tire pressure gauge, Tread-depth gauge, Pocket flashlight, Pencil/pen, Binder with loose-leaf paper. Baggy clothes will not be permitted. Class fee of \$15 (includes cost of Auto Tech Shirt).

CERTIFIED NURSE ASSISTANT (C.N.A.) TRAINING PROGRAM

White uniform pants, navy blue scrub top, white tie shoes, name tag purchased through KACC, pocket notebook, pens, watch with sweeping second hand. A two-step TB test at the cost of \$24, payable to Kankakee County Health Department is required. TB testing will be offered at KACC. If student is absent, TB tests must be done separately through local health department, family physician or occupational health departments and is due before 1st day of clinical. Hepatitis B vaccine (recommended, but not mandatory) at student's expense. Fingerprint Background Check, performed at KACC, Flue shot – when flu shots become available in the fall. Students are required to have the shot or agree to wear a surgical mask during clinical hours when a flu outbreak occurs at the clinical site. Drug screen may be a requirement of the medical facility in which clinical hours are earned.

- Class Fee is due and payable to Kankakee Area Career Center within the first week of School. The fee per year is:

- After successful completion of KACC's and State IDHP requirements, C.N.A. Training Students will take the CNA State Exam (Estimated Fee is \$75.00 based on 2019 Test Fee)
- Flu Shots are highly encouraged and may be mandated by Manteno Veteran's Home.

PC repair toolkit or Phillips-head screwdriver, Small mag light or other mini light, home internet access, 3-ring binder, Pen, Pencil, Notebook, headphones and USB memory flash drive. Optional: A+ Series Manual

CONSTRUCTION TECHNOLOGY

Notebook for classroom, Calculator, 16 oz. claw hammer with unbreakable handle, Speed square, 25' power return tape, Carpenter's pencil, Nail apron – cloth is acceptable, Leather work shoes, OSHA approved hard hat, Safety glasses (first pair provided by KACC), Retractable utility knife, Chalk line, Wire strippers, Four-in-One screwdriver and a small package of color pencils. Appropriate work clothing with no rips, holes, tears or frays. Clothes must also fit properly. Baggy clothes *will not* be permitted. Also recommend cold weather clothing, work gloves, rubber overshoes for mud.

COSMETOLOGY

Students are responsible for purchasing an equipment kit for the first year, second year, and for the summer program. The items provided in the kit are required to progress in the class. Kit fees for fall, first and second year, are due on or before the first day of class. Kit fees and tuition for the summer are due no later than May 15, 2020. All kits meet industry standards and are <u>sold at our cost</u>. Payment plans are not offered. Students will not be enrolled nor will they be able to earn hours toward their Cosmetology license until appropriate fees are paid. Summer Session is NOT an option. Summer curriculum is required in order for students to qualify to licensure examination. Costs are as follows:

Phase I Cosmetology students will need the following classroom supplies: 2-inch binder, notebook, index cards, folder, highlighters, #2 pencils, a box of Kleenex, hand sanitizer and a small box of band aids.

Phase II Fall: \$445 Advanced Kit (or \$600 Salon Pro Kit) Total \$445.00 Minimum

Phase II Summer: \$350 Tuition – No Kit Needed Total \$350.00

Phase II Cosmetology students will need the following classroom supplies: 2 to 3-inch binder, highlighters, pens, regular calculator, and 1 red, two-pocket folder.

Cosmetology Uniform Shirts: Range \$10 to \$15

DRAFTING + 3D DESIGN

Notebook, Minimum 1½ inch, 3-Ringbinder with dividers, Notebook Paper, small calculator, Sketch pad, minimum 8" x 10", Pencils, home computer with internet access recommended for downloading free drafting software (i.e.: *AutoCAD*, *Sketchup*, *Revit*, *Inventor*, *Blender*, *3dsMax*).

Full Set of Scrubs (top and bottom), two 2 ½ inch binders and 1 set of dividers, notebook paper and writing utensils including a highlighter and 1 Post-it Notepad. *ADDITIONAL COSTS*: Class Fee for Second-year Students is \$45, Second-year Students is \$30 to cover cost of ECE Workbooks and CPR Training and Certification.

FIRE-RESCUE-EMR

Pen, Pencil, Notebook paper and 3-ring binder for classroom. Class Fee \$50.00 *ADDITIONAL COSTS*: If applying for EMR License, Fee (was \$55 to IDPH), *Optional:* KACC Fire/Rescue Uniform t-Shirt \$15-\$20.

LAW ENFORCEMENT

Spiral Notebook, 3-Ring Binder, Pens & Pencils, ruler and loose-leaf paper. Additional Costs: American Red Cross CPR Certification \$25.

MEDICAL TERMINOLOGY-BASIC HEALTH SKILLS:

Three-ring Binder with dividers, notebook paper, 3 x 5 index cards, pens/pencils, headphones/buds. If approved for Internship Program, students will need a watch (must have second hand), uniform, appropriate shoes, Pens, Pocket notebook, TB Test and Drug Screen. TB testing may be done through the Kankakee County Health Department or your family physician. Drug screen through the hospital of your choice. *ADDITIONAL COSTS*: Class Fee is \$25.00, covering the cost of First Aid Heartsaver certification.

WELDING TECHNOLOGY
