Kankakee Area Career Center Supply List

AUTOMOTIVE TECHNOLOGY

- Auto I & II: Class fee is \$30 (includes the cost of Auto Tech Shirt, tread-depth gauge, tire-pressure gauge, pocket flashlight, tool pouch and safety goggles)
- Appropriate shoes/boots and clothing; i.e., work pants or blue jeans (NO SHORTS or Pajama Pants) Baggy clothes will not be permitted.
- Safety glasses (the first pair is provided by KACC)
- Pencil/Pen
- Binder with loose-leaf paper

CERTIFIED NURSE ASSISTANT (CNA) TRAINING PROGRAM

- Class Fee is due and payable to Kankakee Area Career Center within the first week of school. The fee per year is \$150. The fee covers the cost of the textbook workbook, CPR card, picture ID badge, royal blue scrub top and black scrub pants.

- Prior to clinical rotation (October):
 - White closed-toe shoes with back such as tennis shoes; crocs not permitted.
 - Watch with sweeping second hand
 - 2 Step TB test & Influenza Vaccine required (offered on-site at KACC through the Kankakee County Health Department or may be done through a family physician or occupational health department at the student's expense.
 - Documentation required to be on file of Hepatitis B Vaccine, Rubella, Mumps, Pertussis and Varicella vaccinations
 - COVID vaccine is recommended; medical facility at the clinical site may require weekly testing
 - Drug screens may be a requirement of the medical facility.
- After successful completion of KACC's and IDPH requirements, CNA Training Program, students will be eligible to sit for the CNA State Exam. The estimated fee is

\$85. The fee is at the student's expense and will be directly paid to the testing site in May. This is not included in the program fee.

- Channel Lock or Vice Grip style pliers (1st-year students)
